ALL SATISFIED THAT FIGHT WILL COME OFF. Promoters Claim the Jeffries and Ruhlin Contest Will Be a Fact.

CINCINNATI, Ohio, Jan. 27.—Among the promoters of the championship bout between Jeffries and Ruhlin and the lovers of the prize fighting sport in general there seems not the least doubt that the big battle will take place on the scheduled time, February 15.

SAUSALITO GOLFERS HOLD COMPETITIONS. Chenery Wins Driving Contest and Major Draper Is Victor on Putting Green.

The competitions in driving and gentlemen members of the Sausalito Golf Club, which have been several times postponed on account of bad weather, took place yesterday.

The day was eminently suitable for golfing, being warm and clear, with scarcely any wind. For the driving competition a portion of the course had been cleared of brush and the grass was in the ground, in the direction of the eighth green.

Each competitor drove three times the 150-yard hole, the longest hole on the teeing ground. The course within which the balls must fall to score was marked by posts, which were placed on a line 150 yards from the hole, and 105 yards, 130 yards and 160 yards. A ball falling on the carry between the 90-yard and 150-yard posts counted one stroke, between the 105-yard and 130-yard posts two strokes, between the 130-yard and 160-yard posts three strokes, and beyond the 160-yard post four points.

The competition for men was won by Leonard Chenery, who drove three long drives, the longest being a 200-yard drive, a possible twelve points. H. Rodman was second with eight points; W. Ames third with seven points; J. W. Mason fourth with six points; J. W. M. Draper fifth with five points; W. Horn sixth with four points; J. M. Kniff and C. Miller tied with two points; E. B. Findley and C. H. Noble also competed.

The ladies drove from a point twenty yards from the hole, the longest being a 120-yard drive, the next pair being at eighty-five yards, and the next at one hundred and ten yards. The competitors were Miss Grace Constance, Miss Constance Borrower, Miss Marian Harrison and Miss Eliza Draper. Miss Grace Martin won with a score of four points.
