


Opposition to a Junket.

Dalzell of Pennsylvania, from the Committee on Rules, presented a resolution for the appointment of a special committee of several members on insular affairs, to make a report on the insular affairs of one political party, to visit Cuba, Porto Rico and the Philippines and report upon the conditions there. Some members objected to a junket proposition. Debate upon the resolution was interrupted by Cannon, who presented a partial conference report upon the sundry civil appropriation bill. The items agreed to comprised all the minor issues, leaving still in dispute the items for the purchase of the old Corcoran art gallery in this city, \$32,000; the appropriation for the Buffalo, Charleston and St. Louis exhibitions and the amendment touching the irrigation of Texas lands.
