Philip S. Fay, Prominent in Business and Political Circles, Dies at His Home in This City After an Illness Extending Over a Period of Months



PROMINENT CITIZEN OF THIS CITY WHO DIED YESTERDAY AFTER A LINGERING ILLNESS.

PHILIP S. FAY, a prominent Democrat and well-known business man of this city, died yesterday morning at his home, 834 Grove street. He had been in ill-health for many months, but it was not until about two weeks ago that his condition became serious. He then commenced to decline rapidly and his death was daily expected. Mr. Fay was born in New York in 1842 and came to California before attaining his majority. For a number of years he was in the employ of the late James Phelan, father of Mayor Phelan. He later engaged in the stock brokerage business and during the great mining excitement several years ago he was one of the best known brokers on Pine street.

MAKES APPEAL TO COURTS.

President Johnson Representing Restaurant Men Asks for Injunction.

Mathias Johnson, proprietor of the restaurants at 25 Montgomery street and 725 Market street, has filed a suit against the Hotel and Restaurant Employees' International Alliance and Bar Tenders' International League of America, the Cooks and Waiters' Alliance Local No. 20, the San Francisco Labor Council, Jefferson D. Pierce, Edward Rosenberg, Walter Goff and R. S. Hamilton to restrain them from "picketing" men near the plaintiffs' restaurants for the purpose of harassing and annoying customers.
