

FEES AND FILING FEES Turn Proceedings into a Veritable Scramble for Gold.

Counsel for Trustees Want a Hundred Thousand Withheld.

The hearing of the petition of Theresa A. Oelrichs, Virginia Vanderbilt and Charles L. Fair for distribution to them of the personal property, the estate of the late James G. Fair has been turned into a scramble for attorneys' fees, with the attorneys representing the trustees and executors leading the scramble.

On the other hand, the attorneys representing the Fair heirs have not as yet been paid. Their fees are all contingent, so yesterday ex-Governor Budd protested and Wheeler protested against the effort of opposing counsel to procure work of the executors and their lawyers was well done. They want to sustain the validity of the trust clause if possible.

These figures show that the estate has certainly prospered, since the death of James G. Fair and furnish a good basis for an argument by the attorneys representing the executors that their demand for a few hundred thousand dollars is naught but reasonable.
