BURNED ALL THE LETTERS. Mrs. Mains, wife of the defendant, and her two little boys, Charles and Clifford, mother of Walter Scott Gifford, the attorney of the mythical syndicate...

Mains explained that he was employed at a salary of \$1000 per annum, payable monthly, and that not needing any of his salary before his arrest he had not drawn any, and after his arrest he could not draw any of the money...
