WELL-KNOWN ATTORNEY DIED YESTERDAY AT HIS PALO ALTO HOME.

HENRY C. FIREBAUGH, ex-Assemblyman from the Forty-first Assembly District of this city, died at his home in Palo Alto yesterday morning at 10:20 o'clock.

He was born in September, 1843, in Bellefontaine, Ohio. When he was 12 years old his parents moved to Crawford County, Ill.

He then journeyed to Indiana to attend school; thence to Delaware and thence to Ann Arbor, from which latter place he was graduated in the law.

He served one term in the Legislature of this State, being a member of the twenty-sixth session. He was a staunch supporter of Senator Stanford in his first election as United States Senator.
