



REPORTERS INCREASE IN TRADE OF ALASKA

Statistics Prepared by Deputy Collector Farley Show This City's Share of Business for Last Year to Be \$5,500,000

ACTING CUSTOMS COLLECTOR W. B. HAMILTON mailed the Chief of the Bureau of Statistics at Washington yesterday the following report prepared by Deputy Collector N. S. Farley by direction of Customs Collector Stratton.

Estimates of the value of shipments from San Francisco to Alaska, and also exports to the British possessions adjacent thereto, since 1890, by calendar years:

(a) - Unusually large amount of between \$400,000 and \$500,000 of steamer material for Yukon River boats (i. e., boats built in sections, shipped to the Yukon, and put together there).

(b) - Shipments on account of salmon industry are practically all made before July 1 of each year. The amount falling off hereafter for the year 1902 is explained by interest parties to be the result of some companies selling out other consolidating companies.

(c) - Mining was carried on in the British possessions adjacent to Alaska as early as 1855. These figures represent supplies forwarded to both mines and trading posts.
