

PROPOSE CHANGE BOARD FAVORS RAILWAYS USING TEN BLOCKS JOINTLY.

Supervisors Reject President Road's Offer to Sell System.

An ordinance was passed to print by the Board of Supervisors yesterday which sets forth a proposal to the electors to amend the charter relating to the regulation of street railroads so as to permit two or more lines of street railroads to use the same street jointly for not to exceed ten consecutive blocks, each paying an equal portion for the construction and repair of the tracks.
