Most of His Estate Is Devised to His Daughter.

Charitable Societies, Friends and Relatives Are Remembered.

The will of the late John Dolbeer of the Dolbeer & Carsons Lumber Company, which was filed for probate yesterday, disposes of an estate estimated to be worth several millions of dollars. Dolbeer, who owned vast shipping and lumber interests, died at his residence, 2112 Pacific avenue, on the 17th inst. He left but one child, Bertha Marion Dolbeer, and to her he bequeaths the major portion of his estate, giving her, in addition to the bulk of the residue of his estate, \$500,000 and stock in the lumber company of which he was a member worth \$400,000. The latter bequest is made in a codicil executed by Dolbeer when he was in New York last April. The will proper was made in June, 1901.

The will provides for the payment of the following bequests: To Ellen Hall, a niece, residing at Epson, N. H., \$50,000 and the residue of the residue; to her husband, C. H. Hall, \$10,000; to Elizabeth C. Phillips of this city, a cousin, and her husband, George Phillips, \$10,000 each; to John C. Chase, a nephew, \$300 a year during the administration of the estate to Eita Marion Warren, \$25,000; to William A. Berkeley, widow of his nephew, W. A. Chase, \$10,000, and to her son, Ralph Chase, \$20,000 and one-eighth of the residue; to John H. Dolbeer, a nephew, of Epson, N. H., \$50,000; to Mrs. Josephine Hanson, widow of Captain W. Hanson, while in command of the U. S. Fish Commission vessels was lost at sea, \$50,000; to Miss Clara Stevenson of Menlo Park, \$50,000; to John Dolbeer Cousins of this city, \$50,000; to William G. Muggan of this city and Percy A. Brown of Alameda, faithful employees of the testator, \$10,000 each; to Peter E. Ryan, his co-executor, \$40,000; to Professor George Davidson, \$50,000. He bequeaths \$5000 to each of the following societies:

Hospital for Children and Training School for Nurses, Boys and Girls' Aid Society, California Children's Hospital, Florence Critchfield Home for Stripped Women and Children, San Francisco Protestant Orphan Asylum, Young Men's Christian Association and the Geographical Society of the Pacific Coast.

In the last clause of the will the deceased directs that he paid to the executors establishing relationship with him, though he denies the right of any person not named in the will to make such a claim. George D. Gray of Oakland, William G. Muggan and the Mercantile Trust Company are named as executors, to serve without bonds.

In that case the Supreme Court held that once a teacher received an appointment she could not be removed unless tried on charges presented in writing and of which full notice had been given.
