

Clydesdale Has Daily Gales ALL THE WAY ACROSS PACIFIC

THE British bark Clydesdale, which arrived Tuesday night from Sydney, had a trip across the Pacific that all hands will remember as long as they go down to the sea in ships.

According to Captain Evans the bad weather commenced on July 9, a few hours after the vessel left Sydney harbor. The storm, which lasted seven days, did its best to drive the lumberer on the rocks of the Australian coast.

The bad weather continued until Tuesday night when the Clydesdale was picked up by a tug and towed to quarantine. Every wind that beset the ship's path during the whole voyage was from some direction and her journey from Sydney to San Francisco was one continuing battle against odds that but for the vessel's stanchness and Captain Evans' splendid seamanship would have proved too much for the Clydesdale.
