WELL ANALYZE STATE'S OILS. Official Researches Are to Favor Miners of Petroleum.

Quest for Ores Upon Coast Continues to Enlist Capital.

Coincidentally with the signs of revival of interest among the petroleum miners of California the State Mineralogist has prepared to secure and publish information of the highest value from a commercial point of view relative to the industry in this State.

A quantity of oil has been gathered, 156 samples from many localities under the direction of the State Mineralogist. Enough has been taken out from the collection to fill exhibition phials, which are given a prominent position where they will be seen by all visitors to the museum.

The mining excitement in Alaska is now directed to stampedes in various directions. Two thousand miners are reported to have stamped from Nome, Dawson, Eagle and Rampart to Tanana.

The Oregon Mining Journal concludes that there will be no mining legislation at the present session of the Oregon Legislature. It says: "Judging from the present indications there is no mining legislation passed during this session."

The Tombstone Prospector says the Dragon range is about to be the field of active mining operations. Several companies are working in that field. The Dragon Copper and Smelting Company has just put up a new plant.

GREAT PAINTINGS BRING PITTANES Old Masters Go a-Begging at New York Auction Sale. NEW YORK, Feb. 28.—Eighty pictures belonging to the J. D. Ichenhauser collection have been sold at Mendelssohn Hall for \$90,105. This was just about as much as three of the best paintings were valued at by the owner. Old masters sold at \$100 and up. Turners and Gainsboroughs were in the 400 class, and a Velasquez brought only \$225. The best picture brought by any picture was for a landscape and cattle by Paul Potter, bought for \$5000. The next highest price was for Sir Joshua Reynolds' portrait of Richard Grenville, first Earl Temple, bought for \$1250. A Rubens sold for \$2250, though it was described as one of the finest examples of the great painter; in fact, the original of his "Plato and Proserpine," painted for the Madrid Museum. An autumn landscape by Ralph Albert Blakeley brought only \$230. The first Turner sold, the Lago di Maggiore, Locomo, was bought for \$425. Its companion piece brought \$500. Raphael's original study for his famous painting, "The Entombment," was bid up to \$1450. Hogarth's "The Greenroom" sold for only \$775, though the auctioneer produced a letter vouching for its authenticity and giving its complete record. Turner's "Ehrenbreitstein," which the

IDAHO-MARYLAND. The Idaho-Maryland, near Grass Valley, which, it is reported, will be reopened, has been closed since 1901. The mine has been worked to a depth of over 2000 feet on the ore shoot, which extends through the mine, beginning at the surface in the Eureka and dipping downward through the Idaho into the Maryland. Crosscuts run in the bottom levels indicate that there are parallel ore shoots in the footwall. The mine is equipped with large hoisting works, forty stamp mill, compressors etc. It is stated that the ore shoot has produced in the three mines \$25,000,000 in gold. WORLD AT LARGE. According to an official statement prepared by the Johannesburg Chamber of Mines £17,000,000 more has been expended in the South African mines than has been taken out in profits, notwithstanding that dividends have been paid for fifteen years. Projected development is estimated to cost £50,000,000. The engineers contemplate working a depth of from 6000 to 12,000 feet. The war losses amounted to about \$125,000 per month. Two thousand sand white men are employed in the mines. The American Mining News believes leasing in the Cripple Creek district is gaining in popularity. It says: "The lease system in the Cripple Creek region has taken a firm hold and is resulting in the opening of much territory that would otherwise remain undeveloped. An unusual number of operations are being leased, but reported since the first of the year, and the prospect seems to be that many will be granted. The days of Cripple Creek's greatest activity have been those in which a large amount of work has been done. Much of the mineral production has been a result of that kind of work together with many of the good discoveries of ore. But, a few years ago, mine owners showed a disposition to abandon the leasing system, either allowing their property to lie idle or working it themselves. The result was that many miners were deprived of employment and left the district for other camps. In a business sense Cripple Creek suffered greatly from this change in policy and development was checked. The most conspicuous case of this kind was that of the Stratton property, under which were included many mining claims that at one time were in part worked by lessee. It is apparent that the managers of the Stratton properties have determined to return to the leasing policy in respect to some of the mining claims. This will give employment to a large number of men. Other properties will be worked in the same way and hence it looks as if the district would regain much of the activity it lost when the leasing system was abandoned.
