The Oceanic Steamship Company's Mariposa arrived yesterday morning from Tahiti. She made the trip in 11 days, 16 hours and 30 minutes.

Among the passengers were J. W. Gilbert and wife, the missionaries who have been in Hikurangi. They give a vivid description of the terrible storm that recently swept over the Pomouti Islands.

The Mariposa brought a good sized cargo, which consisted in part of 63,640 coconuts, 15,617 sacks of copra, 307 packages of shells, 236 packages of vanilla beans, 18 sacks of dried fish and 25 cases of fruit.


