Bank Clearings show a material gain over last year. Wheat market rather firmer in all positions. Barley weakens under large arrivals. Oats and Corn unchanged. Diminished yield of Rye reported. Hay weak under liberal receipts of the new crop. Bran and Middlings steadily held and unchanged. Not much change in Potatoes, Onions and Vegetables. Poultry dull, with a considerable carry-over. Fresh Fruit market liberally supplied and easy. Butter, Cheese and Eggs still in large supply. Dried Fruit quoted rather firmer in New York. Hams, Bacon and Lard advanced 1/2c all around. Hogs lower, with arrivals in excess of market needs.
