POLICEMEN CHARGED WITH PILFERING FROM STORES ON THEIR BEATS.

Confronted With the Proof, They Resign Sergeant and Three Patrolmen Dishonor Good Records by Robbing Those They Swore to Protect.



OAKLAND, Nov. 10.—Accused of pilfering from stores on their beats while on duty and confronted with the evidence gathered by their superiors in proof of the astonishing charges, Police Sergeant Charles E. Clark and Patrolmen Lee E. Andrews, Charles W. Hamerton and John F. Stahl resigned last night from the Police Department rather than face an investigation before the Commissioners. The fact of the resignations was published in this morning's Call.

The men involved have stoutly denied their part in thievery and have asserted that escapades with women while on duty were the causes of their retirement, but the Police Commissioners today made an official statement concerning in brief the true state of affairs.

To the Commissioners the revelations are, to quote the exact language of John E. McElroy, president of the board, "astounding. The board can find no excuse for the offenses laid at the door of four men whose reputations in the Police Department and as citizens had been without blemish. That these men should have taken advantage of their positions and looted the places of business they were paid and sworn to protect seemed almost incredible. But the evidence which was placed before the men themselves was of such a convincing nature that one after the other filed his resignation. In view of the circumstances the Commissioners have decided to make a thorough investigation of the cases tomorrow afternoon before they decide what course to take with the resignations."

Culmination of several weeks' secret watching of the suspected men came Tuesday afternoon and evening. Chief of Police Hodgkins had completed his labors in that regard and had summoned Clark, Hamerton, Stahl and Andrews before him. Each man was interviewed separately and was shown precisely what had been disclosed to his superiors. Each accused officer, after ample consideration, gave in his resignation. Their actions in withdrawing simultaneously leaked out. With it followed rumors of misdoing, but these were doubted, largely because of the standing of the men.

The chief of the case Stahl received word of the death of his father by accident at Portland, Or. Yesterday he departed, giving as his reason for leaving the city the necessity of taking charge of his father's affairs at Portland. His friends were told that he did not intend to return to Oakland, and would send shortly for his family. Andrews and Clark have decided to go to Tonopah or some other mining district in Nevada. Stahl and Hamerton have not officially been heard from, but it is believed that they are in the course of an inquiry into suspicious conduct of one of the men that disclosures which have resulted in the exposure were made to the head of the department.

For some weeks watch had been kept closely upon the four. According to the information in the hands of the Commissioners, the men were not implicated together, but had been acting in a series of petty pilferings from a number of stores. It is asserted that the stealings have not been very heavy in amount. They have been mainly confined to articles such as knives, purses, household supplies, meats, hams, groceries, wearing apparel and the like. But on the score of details the Police Commissioners refuse to talk at present.

Military Instructor Says All His Orders Must Be Obeyed.

TELLS CLASS OF SENIORS NOT TO SULK

OAKLAND, Nov. 10.—Refusing to yield to the request of the senior class for a modification of the obnoxious marching order issued by him two weeks ago, Captain J. T. Nance today gave the class formal notification to that effect. He answered the letter sent to him by the seniors, wherein they suggested the wisdom of amending the instructions which they had disobeyed.

Captain Nance's letter is as follows:

Cadets Joseph P. Loeb, John S. Edwards and J. Gustav White, University of California (the committee from seniors in class military 2A)—Gentlemen: I have received your letter of the 2nd instant requesting, in behalf of the seniors in the class military 2A, that the instructions of this department dividing the class in military 2A into sections and requiring the seniors to march to the rear of the Hall and thence march to the classroom be revoked and that instead certain other named methods be adopted.

In reply I will state that this department must enforce proper military discipline at all times and to have the seniors sulk is an attempt to bring about their resignation. This requirement applies to theoretical instruction as well as to practical instruction. There are various forms of discipline in each of its particular parts. Military discipline is the form prescribed to be enforced during the instruction, however good for its particular purpose it may be, can be considered. Military discipline is brought about and maintained in command by well established methods, and compliance with the requirements of military discipline is not, in any sense, humiliation to any one.

It is not deemed best to go further into the subject matter of your letter in all its parts in the foregoing, your request cannot be granted. The instructions issued must be complied with.

When the course of instruction in this class has progressed further it is probable that the points of view of the instructor and the students will be less wide apart. Then a statement of my position in some of the points raised in your letter will be much better understood.

An earnest effort on the part of the seniors in the class military 2A to comply with the requirements of the department and to place the senior class in a far more dignified and secure position than will a sullen, perfunctory obedience of the instructions or a further attempt to bring about their resignation.
