

WILL IMMEDIATELY BEGIN THE ERECTION OF NEW HOSPITAL Central Emergency in Jefferson Square,

If the present plans of the Health Board mature, work will be begun at once on the erection of a new Central Emergency Hospital in Jefferson square, at the corner of Golden Gate avenue and Gough street.

Inasmuch as the permanency of the new hospital will extend over a period of from one to two years, substantial construction will be carefully reckoned with.

The condition of the people camped in the park is good. There are 1234 persons housed in barracks on the speedway, and 16 new barracks are under way.

The City and County Hospital on Potrero avenue is now in good condition and accommodating about a hundred and fifty more patients than under usual conditions.

Lieutenant Colonel de St. Paul Seltz, in charge of the medical staff, said yesterday that there was no panic among the many patients, and that when there was possible danger from fire the whole force of the hospital was put under strict military rule.

ATTORNEYS MAY USE LAW LIBRARY AT THE UNIVERSITY

President Wheeler Announces That Legal Fraternity Will Be Welcome to Books at Berkeley.

BERKELEY, May 3.—President Benjamin Ide Wheeler of the State University has offered the law library of that institution to the lawyers of San Francisco, who have for the most part lost their collection of law books.

"To the Members of the Legal Profession of San Francisco, Oakland, Alameda and Berkeley—Dear Sirs: The University of California calls attention to the existence in its general library at Berkeley of a well selected law library connected with the department of law of about 6000 volumes.

"The Library will be open the entire seven days of the week as well as in the evenings as a special accommodation for attorneys desiring to use the law library."
