

Steamer Doric Head to Take Freight at Mail Dock.

Will Carry Large Cargo of Merchandise to Orient.

The Occidental and Oriental Steamship Company's steamer Doric will begin taking on her cargo today at the old Pacific Mail dock. She will begin by loading 500 tons of flour. Before she sails on Saturday she will have a general assortment of merchandise in her hold. She will go to Hongkong via Yokohama and Honolulu.

The Doric is the last of the trio of ships of the Occidental and Oriental Company now plying between this port and the Orient. The other ships of this company were the Coptic and the Gaelic. For several years they have been in the trade and have been popular with the traveling public. They would undoubtedly be still in the trade but for the advent on this coast of the big liners, Manchuria, Mongolia, Korea and Siberia, that are able, with the assistance of the China and the boats of the Toyo Kisen Kaisha, to meet all the demands of the trade between here and the Orient. This naturally forced the other ships of the trio out of the business when their charters expired, but the Doric still remains as her charter is still in force.

Buried With Honors.

Money Appropriated by Congress Insures the Beginning of Work \$83,900 IS AVAILABLE

Before final adjournment Congress made a special appropriation of \$83,900 to replace and repair lighthouses that were either destroyed or damaged by the recent earthquake. Of this amount the light at Point Arena will receive the largest sum—\$72,500—as it was demolished. Bonita Point Light, though only slightly damaged, will receive \$6,000 for the rebuilding of the double dwelling of the assistant keepers, while the balance of the appropriation, \$5,400, will go to the Cape Mendocino light for replacing the keeper's house which was destroyed.

Beyond these none of the lighthouses in the Twelfth United States Light-house District suffered to an extent that current appropriations will not supply. The light at Point Arena, though only slightly damaged, will receive \$6,000 for the rebuilding of the double dwelling of the assistant keepers, while the balance of the appropriation, \$5,400, will go to the Cape Mendocino light for replacing the keeper's house which was destroyed.
