ALCOHOL FOR SMALL ENGINES.

With the opening of the coming year the Department of Agriculture will issue a bulletin giving the public all available information on the use of alcohol in any device for the propulsion of small engines. For this purpose Professor Charles E. Lucke of Columbia University has been retained by the department as expert to conduct investigations in the laboratory of the university. The bulletin will contain all the work done on the subject both in this country and abroad, a complete bibliography, together with the results of experiments and the conclusions drawn therefrom. It will be published in the form of a pamphlet on American engines. Those who have patents on the subject of vaporizers, carburetors or complete engines are invited to submit them for tests. These tests will be conducted in the laboratory, except the transportation of the apparatus, and the reports will be published in the bulletin. The merits of the denatured alcohol law are to be shown only by the facts given in the benefit of the test—Omaha Bee.
