Alameda Makes Quick Voyage From Honolulu Despite Rough Weather

The Oceanic Steamship Company's steamer Alameda arrived yesterday after a quick run from Honolulu, considering the heavy weather she encountered for three days in the voyage.

The steamer had on board 1155 tons of freight, in which were included 7000 cases of canned pineapple, 5810 bunches of bananas, 859 hides and 1778 sacks of rice.

Captain Dowdell reports that the weather during the trip was pleasant except for three days, when the wind blew a hurricane and greatly impeded the progress of the ship.

The Pacific Mail Steamship Company's steamer Korea sailed for the Orient yesterday loaded to her capacity with freight. She was given a lively "send off" by a great crowd on the dock to bid farewell to friends and the occasion was enlivened by the Royal Hawaiian Band, which played a number of lively selections from the bow of the vessel and sang a lot of their sweet island melodies.

The departure of the big liner was delayed by Admiral W. T. Swinburne, U. S. N. The admiral and his wife, accompanied by Captain Badger and a party of friends, were enjoying themselves on board the ship. At 1:30 p. m. the gangway was hauled down, the rails were put into place, the forward lines were let go and the steamer was about to proceed to sea when a great commotion was raised on the forward deck.

The discovery was made that Admiral Swinburne and his friends were still on the ship and clamoring to get ashore. Captain Sandberg ordered the gangplank again hauled up to the Korea's sides and after delaying the great ship for over half an hour the admiral and his friends were finally landed on the dock.

Among the passengers was Colonel C. H. Murphy, principal of the Commercial High School, who is making a nine months' tour around the world. Mrs. Kom Sunada, the little Japanese girl who made the picture marriage with the Japanese barber at Sacramento, was on the steamer, ready to return to the Orient, but at the last moment was taken ashore. A writ of habeas corpus had been granted to the Japanese Association of America at the request of her husband and the 16-year-old wife-pledge is now in the custody of the Pacific Mail Company in the detention shed at the Mail dock, awaiting the orders of Judge de Haven.
