

CONSOLIDATION PLAN FOR PACIFIC FLEET

Vessels Designated to Join Command of Admiral Brownson

IN THREE SQUADRONS

Efforts to Be Made to Repair Warships in Coast Navy Yards

WASHINGTON, March 13.—Complete plans for the consolidation into one fleet of all the American war vessels in the Pacific Ocean were made public today by the Navy Department.

At present the warships in the Pacific are organized into the Asiatic fleet and the Pacific squadron. Their consolidation is in accordance with the Navy Department's policy instituted by the abolition of the South Atlantic and European squadrons in the Atlantic and the concentration of all vessels in that ocean under one command.

In a statement from the Navy Department it is shown that the group of ships in the Pacific will remain in the same general position and perform much the same duties they have at present.

The department does not expect to send any of the battleships now in the Atlantic to the Pacific. The first squadron of the Pacific fleet will be made up of the following vessels:

- First division—West Virginia, Colorado, Maryland and Pennsylvania.
Second division—Catawba, Galveston and others of same class.
The second squadron will consist of these vessels:
Third division—Charleston, Milwaukee, St. Louis, Chicago.
Fourth division—Albatross, New Orleans, Cincinnati, Raleigh.
The third squadron will consist of:
Fifth division—Yolande, Quaker, Villalobos, Callao, Paraguay, Panaman, Panay, Arctur.
