AGED PARALYTIC SUES TO RECOVER PROPERTY

John Tench Says Sister and Mrs. McMeekin Took It From Him

REALTY AND MONEY Plaintiff Declares to His Expressed Wish for His Death

OAKLAND, April 8.—John Tench, 74 years of age, living in Park avenue, Alameda, has petitioned the courts to control Mrs. A. Eliza McMeekin, trustee of his property in order that he may recover his possessions. In his petition he states that having suffered a stroke of paralysis early in 1906 he arranged to have his sister, Temperance, whose last name since her marriage is unknown to him, care for him for the rest of his days. In return he gave her a deed of his small lot in Park avenue, with the stipulation that it was not to be recorded during his lifetime. He asserts it was her custom to ask frequently, "Is he dead yet?" and to exclaim, "If he were only out of the way I would have this property to myself."

In October, 1906, Mrs. McMeekin appeared on the scene. Tench's sister, who was 56 years old, became sick, and while dying, it is alleged, was persuaded to give Mrs. McMeekin Tench's bankbook and to make over to her a deed of the property which was immediately recorded. Following the death of the sister, Tench alleged, Mrs. McMeekin has withdrawn at least \$400 of his money from the bank and now claims his home. Having notified Mrs. McMeekin that his sister had broken her contract, Tench has carried the matter into the courts.

HALF MILLION DOLLAR APPROPRIATION TIED UP

SACRAMENTO, April 8.—At the extra session of the Legislature the 1916 \$500,000 was appropriated for a State building in San Francisco. At the time there was not sufficient money in the general fund for the project, so an act transferring money from the school land fund to the general fund was passed. Then a bill appropriating the money from the general fund was made a law. Now a question as to the constitutionality of the acts has arisen and the Attorney General has instructed State Controller A. D. Bagley to refuse to pay out any part of the appropriation until the case has been settled in the courts.

GOLEKER RETAINS TITLE—New York, April 8.—The chess match for the championship of the world between Dr. Emmanuel Lasker and Frank Marshall was begun on January 26, was concluded in this city today, when the champion won the eighth game of the contest after thirty-seven moves. The final score was: Lasker 8, Marshall 0, drawn 7.

CLAIMS CHAMPIONSHIP—Vallejo, April 8.—The Vallejo polo team today won the State championship as the outcome of the failure of the Auditorium to meet in this city on Saturday. The Vallejo team of San Francisco played instead of the Auditorium and was defeated by a 4-1 score.

FACED MEN AFTER HOME—Oakland, April 8.—The California Yacht Club will meet tomorrow evening at former Commodore George M. Shaw's office, 999 Broadway, to decide upon a new site for a clubhouse. Shaw, Fred W. du Brui and Lee Gale have made surveys at the northern point of Sheep Island, where a well-sheltered cove is located.

LOCOMOTIVES IN MOVEMENT—Los Angeles, April 8.—Every overland line on the Southern Pacific leaving Los Angeles today bore black streamers as a token of mourning for Clarence E. Farnington, the engineer who died yesterday as a result of injuries received in the wreck of the Sunset express at Colton on March 28.

PLENTY OF FRUIT CARS—Los Angeles, April 8.—Railway traffic managers of this city announced today that 1000 refrigerator cars would be shipped to California by the Southern Pacific between Los Angeles and San Francisco. With fair weather the cars will carry a quantity of average daily shipments of 175 carloads until the season ends.

Inventor and Wife Will Sail Soon in New Airship

Mrs. Toliver Will Accompany Husband on First Trip of Big Flying Machine

OAKLAND, March 8.—C. H. Toliver, inventor of the largest airship ever constructed on the Pacific Coast, was busy today at Verona, near Pleasanton, completing his preparations for the first flight of the ship, which will probably be attempted this week. Just what the date of the first ascent will be has not yet been determined.

At the intention of Mrs. Kate Toliver, the wife of the inventor, to accompany her husband when the ship rises for the first time, and it is probable that the first flight attempted will be made from Verona, where the airship has been constructed, to San Francisco and back. The ship now lies in a sheltered cradle, deep in a small canyon, the sides of which afford shelter from the wind until the ship is well into the air and beyond danger of collision with obstructions which might cause trouble.
