## Each of the Five Ladies Pictured on This Page Receives a Ten-Dollar Prize

THE apple of beauty fell in all parts of California in awarding the prizes. No city or section of the country seems to have the advantage. On this page five of the twenty-five prize winners are Miss M. Hathaway of Santa Cruz, Mrs. M. Adler of Sacramento, Miss Lena Ferogiaro of San Francisco and Mrs. J. C. Bille of Palo Alto.

Miss Hathaway was born and reared in Santa Cruz and is one of the most admired young women of that favored portion of the state. She is the daughter of Mrs. Sophie Hathaway, a resident of Santa Cruz. Her mother was also a native of Santa Cruz, the daughter of Andrew Thompson, a California pioneer.

Mrs. M. Adler is the wife of a well known musician of Sacramento and resides at 820 Sixteenth street in that city. Previous to her marriage Mrs. Adler was Miss Mabel Boone and her home was in San Francisco. Mrs. Adler has spent almost all of her life in San Francisco, where she was educated. She attended the old James Lick grammar school. Mrs. Adler's parents were natives of the Golden state, but she was born in Kansas City while her parents were on a visit to that city. Mrs. Adler is a beautiful type of the petite brunette and is rated as one of the most attractive of Sacramento's many beautiful women.

Miss Lena Ferogiaro of 463 Waller street, San Francisco, is known as one of the most beautiful young Italian women in the city. She comes of an Italian family that has lived in San Francisco from its earliest days, and in one way or another is related to most of the large Italian families here. She was born at Hermann and Thirtieth streets, in San Francisco, and received her education in the public schools of the city. Miss Ferogiaro is a very striking type of California beauty, with black eyes, rich dark brown hair and very fair skin.
