New York stock market extremely dull. Coppers weak. Cotton from 12 to 16 points lower. Silver still slowly advancing. Exchange rates unchanged. Local bank clearings again surprisingly close to last year's. Business on the local stock exchanges quiet and featureless. Pacific salmon pack said to be the smallest since 1898. Wheat quiet and steady, here and elsewhere. Barley higher, with increased activity in the pit. Oats firm but quiet. Corn and rye dull and nominal. Hay becoming firmer under scarcity of cars. Feedstuffs in ample supply at unchanged prices. Late boats hurt in fresh fruits and vegetables. Poultry market quiet, with a good many hens carried over. Butter, cheese and eggs all higher and firm. Citrus fruits firm, with spot supplies light. Raisins weak. Dried fruits continue very firm. No further change in cured or fresh meats.
