OPPRAGANCE MAN'S OUSE LEGACY BY OPPOSITION

Objects to \$2,000 Granted by Executor of Will Asking New Distribution

OAKLAND, Aug. 31.—Opposition of the Fred Finch orphanage to the final distribution of the estate of the late Caroline Constance Elliott Ver Huell is likely to cut the institution out of a legacy of \$2,000 bequeathed to it through the appointments made by Antoine Borel, Swiss consul at San Francisco, whom Mrs. V. H. Huell named as executor of the will. The will devised a large portion of the estate and left the residue to be distributed among charitable institutions as Borel saw fit. In his plate he named the Fred Finch orphanage, leaving it the residue after other legacies had been paid.

PROFESSOR STEPHENS SAYS AND CRITICIZES WRITERS

That Scribes Have Not Done City Justice

BERKELEY, Aug. 31.—Prof. Henry Morse Stephens informed a great throng of university people in the Greek theater last night that the reconstruction work in San Francisco had not been described properly by writers from the outside, who had come in the interests of eastern weeklies and magazines. Professor Stephens declared that the marvelous strides taken by San Francisco were hardly understood elsewhere in the country, and that visiting writers were wrong to blame for the failure of the country to appreciate San Francisco's achievements in the way of reconstruction.

WOMAN BLOCKS PLOT OF PRISONERS TO ESCAPE

RIVERSIDE, Aug. 31.—The timely warning given by a woman prisoner in the county jail last night frustrated the plot of several desperate prisoners to murder Jailer Evans and liberate every prisoner in the institution and compel them to flee with them. Rowland Fairbanks, who, although he is only 17 years old, has shown himself to be a hardened criminal, originated the plot and was joined in it by several other prisoners who are awaiting trial on felony charges.

This arrangement did not meet the approval of the orphanage, which, according to Borel's attorneys, Smith & Pringle, is seeking to gain a larger portion of the estate. The case was dragged along for 10 years in the probate courts of Alameda county.

The estate, which is appraised at \$150,000, is divided in the will as follows: To four cousins in England, John, Hallam, Marion and Annie Murray, \$10,000 each; to Alfred Chagnon, husband of a deceased niece, and his six children, \$46,000; to the six children of Antoine Borel, \$3,000 each; to Antoine Borel, \$5,000; to J. Henry Meyer of Berkeley, \$5,000; to John Freiler, \$5,000; to each of the following charities \$1,000: California institute for the deaf, dumb and blind at Berkeley; Adult blind home of Oakland, Oakland free reading room, Oakland public library, home for the aged women and the children's home of Oakland.

The children's home is an adjunct of the home for aged women, which is conducted by the Ladies Relief society, more than 20 children being cared for by the society.
