STATUE OF BURNS TO BE ERECTED IN PARK SOON

Weights a Ton and Is Marvellous Representation of Scottish Poet

CAST IN THIS CITY Earl Cummings' Creation Is Ready for Erection Near Stadium

The big bronze statue of Robert Burns, soon to occupy an imposing pedestal in the park, is a marvel of skill and ingenuity as regards design and mechanical work. Weighing a full ton and costing between \$15,000 and \$20,000, its completion was accomplished under great and unusual difficulties. The sculptor, Earl Cummings, sent the original pattern to the De Rome foundry, where it was consumed by the fire of April, 1906. The committee having the statue in charge was determined that, if possible, the immense figure should be cast on this coast and by the particular house of De Rome. Approached on the subject while bricks were yet hot and his foundry lay a mass of twisted and scorched iron and bronze at its feet, the indomitable proprietor answered in few words.

"I'll do it for the honor of San Francisco," he said. A tent was hastily put up, a wheelbarrow of French sand was brought to cover the pattern, scraped from the cellar and the men set to work. They had no way of handling the colossal figure, and the erection of a crane caused a delay of two months, waiting for the walls to go up on the old site. The next thing lacking was a drying oven to dry the mold. One was eventually procured and the work went on. Then there was no furnace large enough to melt the metal, but that obstacle was overcome, too. Finally the big statue was cast.

It took a year to do it. Under ordinary circumstances it would have taken three months. Today it stands in front of the foundry ready for shipment to the park. The committee having the matter in charge comprises John D. McGilvray, John McLaren of the park management, J. McNab Kirkpatrick, the former manager of the Palace hotel, and several other Scots who are well known. The usual ceremonies will be held on the installation of the figure on a site near the music stand, with the hills for the background and the soft green of the foliage all around. Earl Cummings, who, besides being a sculptor is also one of the park commissioners, has seen to it that the statue shall be in a fitting situation, and it will be a distinct addition to the beauty of the park.

CITY SENDS DISPATCH ASKING FEDERAL HELP

Officials Make Plea for Funds to Carry On Sanitation Work

NEEDS ARE RECITED Head of Medical Service Is Given Data on the Aid Desired Here

A lengthy telegram was forwarded yesterday to General Wyman, head of the federal medical service, setting forth existing sanitary conditions in San Francisco and explaining why the municipal authorities were compelled to call upon Washington for assistance in defraying the expenses of the sanitary work now being carried on. The telegram was drafted after an extended conference between Supervisors Sachs and Brandenstein of the finance committee, Dr. Opalus, president of the local health board, and Dr. Rupert Blue, who is representing the federal medical corps in the work of sanitation.

The following is a copy of the dispatch: Owing to the abnormal condition of our streets, sewers, school and other public buildings caused by the great catastrophe of April, 1906, and the drain upon our finances for rehabilitation purposes as a consequence, we are not in a position to continue to advance the money required by the joint health departments for the purpose of eradicating the bubonic plague. We have contributed for this purpose since the United States marine has had charge of the matter, under the direction of Dr. Rupert Blue, the sum of \$40,000 per month. We are now reduced from \$25,000 to \$20,000, and is the only fund available for rehabilitation purposes till July 1, 1908, the beginning of the regular fiscal year. The ordinary rehabilitation purposes is absolutely inadequate. We could, if obliged to, possibly find from all sources \$100,000 per month for the purpose, but a continued contribution of \$40,000 per month to this end would be impossible for us to meet without seriously crippling ourselves. Every cent expended out of the rehabilitation fund is directly and immediately at the expense of the public health of our streets and sewers, work essential for the proper preservation of the public health of our city, inasmuch as the plague has spread to Seattle and the bay counties, and is a source of menace to the entire United States. Under normal conditions, notwithstanding these considerations, the city would have endeavored to meet the major portion of the expense of the work, but the assessment roll materially diminished by reason of the destruction of a vast area of property and its abnormal fiscal condition, and the fact that requiring millions of dollars for its rehabilitation, this extra drain beyond its power to meet.
