

Four Favorites Fall at Emeryville Track

Raleigh's Victory and Four Favorites Are Features

Again yesterday the public went against it at the Emeryville track. Four favorites fell by the wayside and the bookies reaped the benefit.

It was Raleigh's third consecutive victory in clever company and the way in which he scored gave the spectators a high opinion of his prowess.

The very liberal odds of 8 to 5 were laid against Mose Goldblatt's Belmore in the opening race. On past performance he looked like a legitimate 1 to 3 shot among the company which opposed him.

Running head and head with the speedy Lord Provost the first part, he drew away from the pack in the second half and won by several lengths.

Starter Holtman permitted Parole to beat the favorite in the third race. Parole had been accorded stanch support in the betting at 4's.
