NEVADA STOCKS ARE NOT STEADY

Goldfield Consolidated Rallies, Owing to Orders From the East

Goldfield Consolidated, which jumped up 3 1/2 points on Thursday's trading following the announcement that the French syndicate which held an option of 100,000 shares of the merger stock at \$6 per share had exercised its claim, gained 2 1/2 points more yesterday, selling over to the safe deposit company, \$17,000 on deposit at the time of the smash was discharged.

Permission to sue the safe deposit company for \$50,000 was refused the Union national bank of Oakland. Title to the money will, however, be decided in Judge Coffey's court.

SKULL SMASHED IN WITH BIG HAMMER

Missionary Arrives From Kobe With Complaint Against His Stenographer

Rev. J. E. Schultz a Seventh Day Adventist missionary from Korea, and his wife, who arrived here yesterday on the liner Mongolia, are still suffering from the shock of a murderous attack made upon them last November at Kobe by Oscar C. Spohn, a college athlete, who had accompanied Schultz to the orient as a stenographer.

According to the story told by a passenger on the Mongolia, who was in Kobe at the time, Spohn crept into the Schultzes' sleeping apartment during the night, armed with a sledge hammer. He first battered in Mrs. Schultz's head and then attacked the missionary.

36 GO TO DEATH ON DESTROYER TIGER

Shorn in Half by Cruiser, It Goes Down in Deep Water of English Channel

PORTSMOUTH, England, April 3.—Thirty-six men, including Lieutenant Middleton, the commander of the torpedo boat destroyer Tiger, lost their lives in the collision of the Isle of Wight last night between that vessel and the British cruiser Berwick.

An officer who was an eyewitness to the sinking of the Tiger gave the following account of the accident: "The first we knew that anything had happened was when we saw a flash and heard a loud report, which came when the sea water reached the boiler room of the Tiger, causing an escape of steam which must have scalded to death everybody that it touched. The men in the stoke holds must have met a fearful end."

DIRECTORS OF COMPANY ARE ACCUSED OF FRAUD

Half Owners of Building and Repairing Company Demand a Receiver

Thomas C. Drott, George W. Drott and Bud Drott, holders of half the shares in the Pacific Coast building and repairing company, are charged with swindling the holders of the remaining half—John M. Burke Jr., James L. Daly and James E. Turk—in a suit filed by them yesterday. It is charged that Thomas Drott, who is the president, fraudulently caused his wife, Addie Drott, to sue the company for \$3,014.42 and had the property sold at a sheriff's sale. Drott confessed judgment for the amount, but Judge Trout has granted a stay of execution and ordered the Drotts to show cause on Tuesday next why a receiver should not be appointed.
