Samuel C. Hammond Succumbs to Disease Caused by Experiences in Great Fire

James Peverly Hodgdon Passes Away, a Sufferer Six Years From Accident

Samuel C. Hammond, who had been for many years one of San Francisco's most prominent retail businessmen, died in a local hospital three days ago.

For 23 years Hammond was in partnership with A. H. Brod, first in the Justice market in "fourth street, then in the Spreckels market.

As president of the Retail Butchers' board of trade he was for the years of his incumbency noted for his stern uprightness.

James Peverly Hodgdon, one of the oldest and most popular railroadmen on the Pacific coast, passed away at his home, 109 Bartlett street, at 3:30 o'clock yesterday afternoon after a long illness.
