Shasta Copper 1907 Totals \$35,800,000

Keswick Smelter Again Running and Unworked Ore Body Being Explored by Drillers

Of leading importance in the current news of California mines is the resumption of work at the Keswick smelter by the Mountain copper company.

While these figures will surprise many they should not be taken too seriously, for need of structural materials for street building, etc., has been the main reason for the production of \$1,772,957, and now ranks high in the procession of counties. Shasta has a lead of many millions ahead of any other county in the last 14 years, with copper as the principal reason for its ascendancy.

The Morning Star mine at Badger Hill, Nevada county, may be reopened. Two years ago a new mill was placed on the mine, but financial difficulties prevented its completion.

The Mammoth copper company is reported to have been the leading copper concern in Shasta in mineral output for 1907. It turned out some millions of pounds more of copper than the Mountain copper company did.

The principal ore mass that has been developed lies on the southern side of the mountain above Slick Rock creek and the greater portion of the ore body has been developed from that locality.

The Iron mountain began its producing career in 1897, when James Salie, with Alvin Potter, began to investigate the ores, assays of the surface revealed the presence of gold and silver. Not until 1905 was copper made the leading feature.

The Goldfield News says about the work on the mines of the Goldfield Consolidated: During the month of August the Combination mill treated 2,472 tons of ore from the Combination mine.

While some attention has been called to the reported falling off in the gold production of California in 1907, the totals for gold output from the beginning of the present year to the present time make refreshing reading.

It may be considered odd to class San Francisco as one of the mining counties of California, yet the fact is that this county has produced in mineral substances, nonmetallic, of course, and exclusively ranked among the structural materials, the aggregate of more than \$1,200,000 in the last 13 years.
