OAKLAND, July 18.—From the pulpit of the First Presbyterian church, the platform from which many orthodox disciples of Calvin have expounded his uncompromising theories of eternal punishment, Rev. Charles T. Russell, New York, assured a congregation of 1,500 persons this afternoon that in reality there was no hell, that the word in its biblical usage was merely synonymous with the grave.
