WILL ESTABLISH A PLAYGROUND IN 1910

Money Will Be Set Aside to Start the Equipment of Fields

OAKLAND, July 21.—Eight thousand dollars will be apportioned to the first playground fund in the budget for the fiscal year 1909-1910 for the equipment of the various grounds which have been acquired by the city and placed under the jurisdiction of the playground commission.

Public improvements already provided for by ordinances or contemplated by the city council have made it impossible to apportion more than approximately \$8,000 to the playground fund.

Mrs. Elizabeth Gerberding Makes an Able Address at Reform Congress

BERKELEY, July 21.—At a meeting of the congress of reform of the California Woman's Christian temperance union, largely given over to the discussion of the equal suffrage problem, Mrs. Elizabeth Gerberding, representing the Woman's League of Justice, gave a stirring address this afternoon.

"Of what avail," Mrs. Gerberding declared, "is it to rear a son in a protected, well regulated home through the door of which he steps into a world where corrupt practices are condoned; where man is a selfish beast, distrustful of right or justice; where everything, in fact, is in direct contradiction to the teaching of the home! This carefully reared son is apt to conclude that he must yield to conditions as he finds them or go down in the struggle. The temptation is too great for the average man. Carry the thought still further. It may be the fate of this son to be on trial for his life. In a country where the law can be bought as so much merchandise, what chance has he for securing a fair trial?"

MUCH IS AT STAKE

The fundamental principles of the government are at stake and it behooves every man and every woman to help the cause by allying himself or herself on the side of the right. A favorite argument is that graft must always exist. So must burglary; so must murder; but is that any reason why the guiltless should calmly stand by and see murder committed?
