

CALLS FOR MILITIA AND NOW SENDS BILL

McCloud Lumber Company Asks \$632.01; Strike Costs State \$5,905.45

[Special Dispatch to The Call] SACRAMENTO, Aug. 4.—The McCloud River lumber company, which recently called upon the state militia for help in quieting a strike among the lumber jacks, presented a bill to the state today for \$632.01 for expenses incurred by the company.

The main account of the lumber company is for \$298.20 for transportation of the militia over the company's railroad from Sisson to McCloud. There is also a bill for \$211.95 for meat and supplies. Another bill was for \$23.54 for telegrams between the officials and 10 cents for envelopes.

The McCloud insurrection, as it is termed by Adjutant General Lauck, so far has cost the state \$5,905.45. The three companies of militia drew \$3,831.52 in pay, besides the \$647.70 for 1100 and staff, and \$284 for hospital officers.

SCHOOL ATTENDANCE RECORD—Vallejo, Aug. 4.—Just entering the Vallejo high school, Miss Eugenie Blackwood has been awarded a gold medal by the board of education of Vallejo because of her attendance record made during her school life. She has not been absent or tardy since starting to school in the lowest class in the local schools. SERIOUS REVOLT FOLLOWS FAMINE

Rebellion in Progress in the Great Mohammedan Province of Kansu, China

VICTORIA, B. C., Aug. 4.—The steamer Tango Maru, from the orient, today brought news of a rebellion in the great Mohammedan province of Kansu, China, following a famine.

One of the members of an American exploring party sent out by R. S. Clark of New York of the American geographical society, a Hindoo topographer, has been killed.

Several walled cities, including Yulinfu, Yenafu, Sitchou and Mitsuhsien, were besieged by the rebels, against whom imperial troops, foreign drilled and capable men, had been sent.

The Tango Maru brought news that there has been a recrudescence of piracy in south China and some tragic affairs are reported, seven persons being roasted to death by pirates near Shuntak after the capture of the castle like house owned by one of the local officers.

Although the Chinese garrison was but 300 yards away, no troops came to assist the besieged household or succor them when the pirates burned them alive.
