White Steam Car Owners Describe Best Route to Take to Los Angeles

Dr. and Mrs. Tate and Dr. and Mrs. H. T. Webster have just returned from a three weeks' trip to Los Angeles in Dr. Tate's White steamer and report the roads to be in splendid condition. Dr. Tate has the following to say about his trip:

"When we left Oakland we were prepared for some bad roads, but with the exception of six miles of sand and three of rock south of Soledad we found none that we could complain about. We crossed several steep grades, but they were made with comparative ease, with the exception of San Juan, which is somewhat cut up. The trip was made by way of Oakland to San Jose, Gilroy, Soledad, Jolon, Paso Robles, Arroyo Grande and Santa Maria. At Santa Maria the road, as mapped out, is not as good as the one that turns off to the right, and I would advise any one taking the trip to take the road to the right."

CONDemn WATER OF COUNTY LINE

City Chemists Doubt Purity of System Supervisors Planned to Purchase

The water supply of the County Line water company, whose system the supervisors proposed to purchase for the city at \$20,000, has been found to be infected with bacteria by Dr. Rykoge, city bacteriologist. As he reported to buy the supply only upon proof of its purity, the first movement toward immediate ownership of a water system by the city seems likely to fall.

The County Line company operates in the Rais tract along the bay where road on this side of Visitation. Of the three samples examined that from the Suell reservoir was reported yesterday to the supervisors to have 400 or "very few" colonies of bacteria to the cubic centimeter, while that from the County Line pumping station has 1,900, and from the tap at 129 Tucker avenue 1,400 colonies, which are considered "numerous."

Chief Chemist C. W. Beaver adds a report that the analysis of many samples "compels strong suspicion of the purity of these waters." He continues: "Unless regular and frequent chemical and bacteriological examinations extending over a period of at least one year should show no particular change in the chemical composition, or should fail to reveal the presence of sewage bacteria, the use of these waters as a source of supply is to be condemned."
