ROAD MAY REDUCE TARIFF
LOS ANGELES, Nov. 27.—T. M. Schumacher, vice president of the Western Pacific, in charge of traffic, was here today, he denied having information of a plan to secure the Gould transcontinental connection, an entry into southern California over the Tonopah and Tidewater. He also denied that he did not know whether the new road would make a direct bid for southwestern business, but added that it would make an aggressive campaign for everything it could get after December 1.

PLANS FOR NEW SERVICE
SEATTLE, Nov. 27.—The principal subject discussed yesterday by President Robert S. Lovett of the Union Pacific and Southern Pacific railroads and other officials of the Harriman system in this city was the train service to Seattle which will begin January 1, when this city will become the northwestern terminus of the system. The number of trains, time of arrival and departure, speed, etc., are involved, and the board is expected to make a decision of all the time tables of the system. A final decision was not reached and the officials on their arrival in Portland tonight will discuss the matter further.
