TRAGIC STORY OF CZARINA IS TOLD

Sole Survivor Describes the Scene on Ill Fated Ship Before Wreck

With Death Waiting to Clutch Him Master Asked for a Chew of Tobacco

Harry H. Kentzel, the only survivor of the 24 men on board, told his story of the tragic wreck of the Zarina in Coos bay at the official inquiry held yesterday by O. F. Bolles and John K. Pulger, inspectors of hulls and engines.

In his testimony Kentzel covered the period from noon of the 12th of this month, when the ship steamed out from Marshfield, to the time late the same day when he was picked up on the beach seemingly dead, his stiffened arms clasping a piece of wreckage.

THE Boudoir. Head massage consists in moving the scalp over the skull, with three different motions. Culinary Notes. Angel Food Cake (Mrs. N. O. Brown, Turlock).—Six to eight cups of flour, one and a half cups of granulated sugar and a scant cupful of flour. Beat until white the whites of 10 eggs, add a pinch of salt, the whites are half beaten add a heaping teaspoonful of cream tartar. Fold the beaten whites into the creamed whites very gently, do not beat as for other cakes; flavor with a teaspoonful of vanilla extract. Bake in round pan with horn in center. Do not grease pan. Bake in very slow oven for 1 hour and 15 minutes. Remove from oven, turn upside down and allow it to cool thoroughly before taking it out of pan.

Chicken a la Mode (Mrs. M. Vickers, 1126 E. Street).—Pour a large cupful of olive oil in the bottom of an iron pot that has a closely fitting cover. When this is hot slice an onion into it, and cook slices until they are yellow. Prepare the chicken as for fricassee and

drop into the boiling oil; season with pepper, salt and a bunch of parsley and let together in the pot until the chicken is tender. Then remove the chicken to a platter and serve with a sauce made of the fat in the pot, the butter and the parsley.
