The latest addition to the roster of the A. F. of L. of these independent labor bodies is the western federation of miners, numbering some 40,000.

Strong moral and financial aid has ever been forthcoming from all parts of the United States whenever the western miners have been waging their great battles for living conditions.

The western federation of miners has stood apart from the American federation of labor on account of tactical differences, real or imagined, yet for the last 15 years the two bodies have been morally united.


Branch 5 of the amalgamated society of carpenters and joiners will host this evening at a "ladies' night" in its hall in the Building Trades temple.
