

PRESIDENT JORDAN GOING TO EUROPE

[Special Dispatch to The Call] STANFORD UNIVERSITY, May 9.—President David Starr Jordan, at the close of the present semester is to enjoy the first extended vacation in 30 years, when he will be absent in Europe for about nine months.

LIBERALS CARRY SPANISH ELECTIONS

MADRID, May 9.—Partial returns from yesterday's elections in 32 provinces show the following results: Liberals, 94; conservatives, 35; republicans, 35; socialists, 1; Carlists, 6. According to the newspaper A B C, Premier Canalejas will have 225 supporters in the cortes, while the conservatives will hold 98 seats, republicans 46, Carlists 8, Catalinists 8 and independent 11.

LITTLE CHANGE IN FRENCH ELECTIONS

PARIS, May 9.—Practically complete returns from the recent elections indicate that the political complexion of the new chamber of deputies will not be greatly changed from that of the preceding body. The radical and socialist groups again will have an overwhelming majority.

CONSTITUTION IS URGED ON CHINESE

PEKING, May 9.—An imperial edict issued today summons the national assembly to meet October 3 and announces the appointment of 96 members representing all classes. The edict urges the people to prepare for a constitution and parliament.

DEMENTED HERDER CRUCIFIES HIMSELF

SAN BERNARDINO, May 9.—While brooding over the possible ill effects of the comet's visit, Paul Hammetton, a sheepman and prospector, became insane and crucified himself, according to mining men who arrived with him yesterday. Hammetton was found where he had nailed his feet and one hand to a crude cross he had erected near the Discovery gold claim last Friday.

MOB OF MINERS ATTACK WORKMEN

PITTSBURG, Kan., May 9.—Eight hundred striking miners, mostly foreigners, but under the leadership, it is said, of Americans, attacked the mines at the Sheridan coal company at Fuller, near here, today, drove the engineers and pumpmen from their work and extinguished the fires under the boilers. At the Chapman shaft a number of the hotheads attempted to throw an engineer into the firebox.

TAFT IS FOR PEACE WITH ARMAMENT

HARTFORD, Conn., May 9.—Much enthusiasm was injected into tonight's session of the New England arbitration and peace congress by the reading of letters from President Taft and others, containing expressions of their sentiments toward the peace movement. The letter from President Taft indicated that he is in favor of international peace and arbitration, but is not in favor of giving up the army and navy.
