

SHOW GOOD WILL
Professor Morse Tells of Friendship of Southern Nations

Important Treaties Arranged and Disputes Settled at Conference

BERKELEY, Oct. 16.—Prof. Bernard Moses, head of the department of political science at the University of California, arrived home today from Buenos Aires, where he served as one of eight delegates from this country to the international conference of American states.

Recognized as an authority on these subjects, Professor Moses returned with a significant report of the work of the conference as ministers plenipotentiary to the centennial celebration of the independence of Chile, investigated political conditions in the South American republics and studied the relations between this nation and its Latin neighbors.

Four matters of deep concern to every nation were taken up by the delegates, according to a program. In 26 states it is considered certain that the path prepared by the conference will be followed.

As for the attitude of the Latin American nations toward the Monroe doctrine, I found them no hostile. I have learned to fear no aggression by the United States, and now look upon the United States as a friend.

Regarding the opening of the Panama canal, the conference decided to leave arrangements of celebration to the governing board of the conference. This is composed of the ministers of the nations at Washington.

The delegates were given royal hospitality in the Argentine and the United States received from the department at Washington credentials as ministers plenipotentiary on special missions to the centennial at Chile.
