NO INCREASE OF BERKELEY POLICE

Mayor Wilson and Council Tell Merchants Exchange Funds Are Too Low

BERKELEY, Aug. 22.—Mayor Stitt Wilson and the city council declared today that the municipal finances will not permit an increase of the police force, which was demanded this morning in a petition from the Merchants' exchange.

They requested that the force be increased to a ratio of one patrolman for each 1,000 inhabitants. During the winter months, they said, from midnight until 3 a. m. three patrolmen cover the entire city.
