Little Cruiser is All Dressed Up Ready for Panama Canal Duty

THE little cruiser Yorktown, in a coat of clean white paint, lay at anchor yesterday off the foot of Folsom street and excited an unusual interest among the bay excursionists and party passengers. The Yorktown, commanded by Captain Anderson, has been at Mare Island for some time, but recently was ordered south to go on patrol duty at Ancon.

When the Yorktown first appeared on this coast its advent excited tremendous interest, for it was then one of the best and most modern of the United States Navy's gunboats.

When the Yorktown arrived here yesterday morning at 9:40, Captain Hanna reported that as they made Point Sur shortly after sunrise, the way for the vessel was clear of the horn and into San Diego harbor.

No definite date has been set for its departure, but it is expected to depart the western end of the Panama canal.
