Governor Hiram W. Johnson heads the California Roosevelt delegate ticket, which was completed and announced formally yesterday by the executive committee of the Roosevelt Progressive League. Mrs. Florence Collins Porter of Los Angeles and Mrs. Charles D. Blaney of San Jose are the representatives of the women republicans of California on the ticket. Mrs. Porter received one of the at large nominations and Mrs. Blaney is one of the nominees from the eighth congressional district. Governor Johnson, Meyer Lisner, chairman of the state central committee, and former Governor George C. Pardee, with Mrs. Porter, are the nominees for delegates at large. The ticket nominated by the Roosevelt league is genuinely representative of the administration. That is, it is republican party and even more representative of the governor's official family. One-half the ticket is composed of the central committee members of the immediate families of state officers. FIGHTING MEN, ALL. A majority of the men on the Roosevelt ticket, which in all fairness may be called a Johnson ticket rather than a Roosevelt ticket, are known throughout the state. By those familiar with the practical side of California's politics it might fairly be called a fighting ticket. Nearly every man on the Roosevelt ticket could become the inciting factor in a good, stiff fight in his own district with slight effort. Most of them have been identified with both local and state fights. Only one nominee on the Roosevelt ticket was a delegate to the last republican national convention. That is Philip Bancroft of San Francisco, who four years ago, was elected by the fourth congressional district convention. Meyer Lisner, candidate for delegate at large, is chairman of the republican state central committee and formerly was the municipal boss in Los Angeles. George C. Pardee of Oakland, former governor of California, is a member of the state conservation commission, appointed by Governor Johnson. The commission was created upon the governor's recommendation at the regular session of the legislature in 1911, and the funds to keep it in existence were replenished at the extra session last December. KENT IN ARENA AGAIN. The nominees for the first congressional district are Congressman William Kent of Marin county, who has announced his retirement from the congressional field, and Ralph W. Bull of Eureka. Bull is the publisher of a newspaper in Eureka. He joined the Johnson force near the end of the 1910 primary fight in which he defeated the leader of the Curry forces in Humboldt county. He was appointed to the conservation commission by Governor Johnson. The second congressional district representatives are S. G. Beach, a millionaire of Placerville and W. D. Tillett of Redding. Beach is a mining man. The third district is represented by the Roosevelt ticket by Clinton L. White, former mayor of Sacramento, and Sumner Crosby of Pittsburgh. Crosby is a member of the lower house of the legislature and was elected from Alameda county. He is in the lumber business. Charles S. Wheeler, attorney, and Philip Bancroft, secretary of the local county committee are the San Francisco nominees from the fourth congressional district. The fifth district places go to Francis J. Henry, and John H. McCallum, a lumber dealer. The sixth district is represented by Chester E. Snook of Oakland and C. C. Young of Berkeley. Snook is the close political associate of former Governor George C. Pardee, by whom he was chosen for the berth of attorney to the board of regents. He was one of the framers of the Alameda county delegation to the state convention in 1910 upon which W. R. Davis was denied a place. FRESNO EDITOR NAMED. Chester H. Next Friday and Saturday will be pencil days in this city and 80,000 red and black pencils are ready for sale on those days. The proceeds of the sale will be devoted to the fund for the support of the San Francisco Nursery for homeless children at Fourteenth and Lake street. The pencils are to be sold by the women managers of the nursery and their assistants, who will occupy stands in office and public buildings. The managers of the nursery will take orders for wholesale trade during the week until Friday, but there will be no retail sale until that day and no pencils will be delivered until after Friday. The pencils may be ordered from any of the managers or at the pencil headquarters committee room, 530, at the St. Francis. The pencils are octagonal in shape, red and black in color and are inscribed with the words "Let us forget." The pencils will cost 10 cents each whether sold singly or by wholesale. Mare Island Notes

[Special Dispatch to The Call] MARE ISLAND, March 23.—The first work on the A train for the colling apparatus that is to be used aboard the Jupiter was commenced in the hull division today. The Jupiter will have a far different appearance from any of the other collers as a result of the installation of this apparatus, which consists of eight A shaped steel frames rising to a height of 34 feet above the deck of the vessel. These frames are carried the trolleys by which the buckets for coaling the ships are operated, doing away with the masts and boom heretofore used for this purpose. The apparatus has a capacity of 100 tons per hour per hatch, requiring 80 tons per hour for the Jupiter. The vessel is to have a capacity of 12,000 tons.

NEBRASKA TAKES
BRYAN

Nebraskan Again Tells Why He
Can Not Support Candidacy
of Governor Harmon

WASHINGTON, March 23.—Senator Hitchcock of Nebraska today issued a statement replying to the declaration of William Blaney, of the late John and Harman was endorsed by the Nebraska primaries he would not go to the convention as a delegate. Senator Hitchcock characterized the Blaney statement as an attempt at dictatorship "which Nebraska voters would not tolerate." He added that while Harman was his personal choice, he would not support him if Governor Harmon was endorsed by Nebraska democrats. Commenting on Bryan's opposition to Governor Harmon, Hitchcock said: "The assertion made by Bryan that Harman has the support of Wall Street is utterly without proof or foundation so far as I know. Whenever Bryan's opposition to Harman he first assumes and then asserts that Wall Street is for that. Certainly Wall Street has no reason to be for Harman. As governor of Ohio Harman has shifted \$2,000,000 of his own money from the people on to the railroads, which are largely owned by Wall Street in California."

Bryan Stands Pat

LINCOLN, Neb., March 23.—When questioned tonight as to whether Bryan wished to make reply to United States Senator Hitchcock's statement regarding the position taken by Bryan on Governor Harmon's presidential candidacy, the following was given out at Fairview: "No man ought to speak for the democracy of Nebraska unless he can carry out the spirit as well as the letter of the instructions. If the democracy of Nebraska is to be represented by delegates who can support him not only conscientiously, but with enthusiasm, Bryan cannot support him in the convention on any conditions. He is not willing to accept any co-operation between two progressive candidates—Wilson and Harman, and if he can do that he will go to Baltimore and ally himself with the plutocratic influences that are attempting to force Harman upon the party."
