RETIRED BUSINESS MAN PASSES AWAY

Charles James King, a native of Georgetown, El Dorado county, died in this city late Saturday night. He was 68 years of age, a son of James King of William, who, in 1856, was editor of the Evening Bulletin and who, on May 14 of that year, was assassinated by James P. Casey.

He was active in fraternal societies as past master of Pacific lodge of the Masons, Past high priest of San Francisco lodge of the Royal Arch Masons, a member of the Knights of the Macabees of the World, a member of the Society of California Pioneers, and a past president of the Sons of the American Revolution.

He was a widower and leaves three children, two brothers and two sisters, one being Mrs. Russell J. Wilson.

ANARCHIST TRIES WILSON A TRIAL

In demanding a jury trial for violating a city ordinance, Alexander Horr, self declared anarchist, yesterday demanded that a subpoena be issued by Police Judge Shortall for Mayor J. Stitt Wilson of Berkeley to appear in the courtroom on May 14, the date set for Horr's trial.

Horr declares that the socialists are trying to effect the downfall of the anarchists and that Wilson is the prime figure in the movement.

Horr was arrested April 28 under the name of James Swinton for carrying a banner at Van Ness avenue and Sutter street bearing the words, "Emma Goldman will speak here May 19."

Both prisoners acknowledge that they participated in the fight on the back of the car which resulted in Rollis being thrown into the street while the car was in motion. Spohn and Quinones are charged with assault to commit murder.
