COURT DECISIONS BY CITY'S COUNSEL

Under Ruling Oakland Can Not Hope to Acquire Water Front Street Ends

OAKLAND, June 7.—William R. Davis, counsel for the city in the water front street ends case, today sent to the city council a summary of the recent decision of the supreme court upon a second appeal, which was lost by the city. Davis goes into detail on both decisions and says in part: "The decision upon the first appeal did not fix or adjudge the period to which the effect of the compromise ordinance of April, 1868, applied, that is, whether only on and after the date of April, 1868, or whether their effect reached back by confirmation to the very earliest ordinance and the town's deed of 1852 to Carpenter, so holding, the court now proceeds to discuss and adjudge the period to which the compromise of 1868 applied, the period of its operative effect by relation back through confirmation of the earliest ordinance and deed, and holds that the effect of the compromise of 1868 was to confirm and ratify the town's early ordinance and transfer of the lands between the lines of ordinary high and low tide.

PLENARY POWER IN STATE "That the language of the compromise ordinance of 1868 is such that, allowing that street ends had been dedicated across the mudflats prior to 1868, the compromise ordinance of 1868 operative to revoke any and all such dedications, these ordinances treating the water front, or mudflats, as an entirety, not mentioning or expressly reserving streets—holding also upon this point that, as those ordinances gave plenary power to vacate highways and streets, it has also the right to delegate that power to a municipality as its governmental instrument for that purpose.
