

SHIP STRIVES FOR Movements of Vessels in Parts of the World

R. M. S. Tahiti Will Try to Break Its Own Figure of 2,800 Miles

When the R. M. S. Tahiti of the Union line sails for Sydney Wednesday the wireless installation of the liner will be set in intermittent operation in an effort to eclipse the long distance record of 2,800 miles already held by the vessel.

The Tahiti is well booked with passengers. Many of the passengers will make the trip to Papeete to witness the native fetes celebrating the fall of the bastille, which are held annually July 14 and are attended annually tourists from all parts of the world.

Converted into a molasses tanker by the Matson company, the old United States ship Bennington will be taken from the Union line works, where it was being repaired and towed to Honolulu by either the Lurline or Hilonian of the company's fleet.
