Change of Ownership Will Take Place July 1, Say Parties Interested

Arrangements for the purchase of the brokerage business of Logan & Bryan in this city by Ferdinand Thieriot and Harold L. Mack, who recently bought out the San Francisco interests of Byrne & McDonnell, have been completed and the deal will go through about July 1.

The chief feature of yesterday's trading on the stock and bond exchange was the drop in Associated Oil.

Great Western Power 5 per cent bonds advanced to 88, a gain of one-eighth of a point over Wednesday's figure.
