

NEW MOTORCYCLE IN LOCAL FIELD Henderson Company Selects Frank Burnside as California Representative; Notes

By LEON J. PINKSON The same rapid strides that have characterized the progress of the motor car industry in the United States are reflected in the advancement of motorcycle trade and the popularity of the

two wheeled "car" is steadily increasing. With the motorcycle at the present moment it is almost a repetition of the automobile a year or so ago, the factories can not turn them out fast enough to meet the demand, and like in the motor car, California is one of the biggest users. The manufacturers are increasing their plants to meet the demand, and as a result of enlarged factory facilities the Henderson Motor Company of Detroit is now to bid for its share of the California business and has just appointed Frank Burnside as its representative in this state.

The "wheel" is capable of developing high power, and, according to Burnside, is a combination of "silence, comfort, speed, durability and embodies every essential to motorcycle efficiency."

In a series of tests about the city Burnside has shown the machine will run through the heaviest sandy stretches and over the worst roads that can be found without the slightest injury to the wheel in any way. 
