### CONVICTED EDITOR FREE; PLEADS FOR HIS ENEMY

Former Mayor Speer Escapes Jail and Fine in Denver

DENVER, Aug. 10.—The fine of \$1,000 and sentence of five days in jail recently imposed on Former Mayor Robert W. Speer for contempt of court in connection with articles in a paper of which Speer is editor, was set aside today by District Judge E. L. Shattuck, and Speer was purged of contempt. The action followed a statement by Speer that he had purged himself of contempt by his answer and testimony in the trial. Speer asked the court to take similar action in the case of P. G. Bonfile, part owner of a rival paper, who recently was sentenced to 30 days in jail and to pay a fine of \$5,000. The court declined to take the initiative, but added, "The doors of the court are wide open."




