

THE PACIFIC MAIL LINER SAILS TODAY for Orient With 735 Passengers and Freight

THE Pacific Mail liner Manchuria, Captain Andrew Dixon, will sail at 1 o'clock this afternoon for the far east with a record crew of passengers and a full cargo of general merchandise.

The liner will carry 66 second cabin passengers and 490 in the steerage. The heavy travel is due to the fact that the last two Pacific Mail sailings have been small ships.

The majority of the passengers are booked through to China and Japan and Manila. Among the passengers for Honolulu will be some prominent residents of the island port.

A. J. Fry, assistant to the vice president and general manager of the Pacific Mail company, his wife and son, will be passengers on the Manchuria. It will be Fry's first vacation in five years and he will be away until next February.

The passengers will include 50 missionaries and 26 insular employes returning to the Philippines. Melrose sticks in the mud. The Southern Pacific creek route steamer Melrose stuck in the mud yesterday in Oakland creek and was delayed for more than an hour.
