

NAPA VALLEY FAMOUS FOR ITS SPRINGS

Scenic Drives, Health Giving Baths and Country Life

Dancing Pavilions, Swimming Tanks and Drives Along Wooded Roads

Only 50 miles from San Francisco and easily reached by fast train service, Napa county watering places are preferred to all others by a constantly increasing number of those who prefer its quiet valley life to the more strenuous amusements of other localities. But to enjoy the idyllic country life requires no hardships. Mineral springs in the county are recommended by physicians everywhere for their health giving properties.

Unique among the attractions of the state is the famous petrified forest of Napa county. There the monarchs of other ages, turned to stone, show in unyielding outline every cell of the ancient tree.

Napa today is now one of the best known resorts of the state. The springs from which the water comes are located at this resort. Tennis, croquet, shuffleboard, billiard and pool tables, a large swimming tank, bowling alleys and a fine dancing pavilion all assist in making the resort one of the most delightful in the state. One feature making the resort particularly nice for families is the great care taken of children. Even ponies have been provided for making the little ones happy.

Though affording all the delights of country life, every modern convenience is included in the hotel. Mail is delivered twice daily, and the long distance telephone enables the business man to keep a constant touch with his affairs.

Toland house is a well known resort of Napa county with a long list of discriminating guests. The famous White cottages, supplied with the purest of spring water, afford a delightful means of spending the summer. The establishment has its own dairy, and the tables are supplied with fresh vegetables from the surrounding country.

St. Helena White Sulphur Springs is another resort where nature furnishes life giving mineral waters. The appointments of the resort are good, special care being taken to insure a good table. A delightful sulphur bath is one of the many attractions.

Atta Loma is a delightful family resort on Howell mountain, where at reasonable rates summer recreation for the whole family may be obtained.

Toland house, on Howell mountain, is a quiet family resort, where a pleasant summer can be spent at a reasonable cost. Wilson's inn, near Atlas, furnishes a beautiful mountain home.

Steady Brook farm, near Callisto, is a quiet resort where families with children are welcome. The Summit hotel, now under new management, is a delightful family resort.


The Vallejo White Sulphur Springs combines with city advantages the health giving properties of its waters and a well appointed hotel.

MIRROR LAKE YOSEMITE VALLEY

Mount Shasta and Shasta Springs are famed throughout the United States for their majesty and healthfulness respectively. Crowned with eternal snows, Mount Shasta stands like a northern outpost of the state. Near it are virgin forests of pine and oak and the weird spires of Castle Crags.

Hunting big game finds its highest development in the wilds of this northern county. Deer bear and other difficult prey of the rifle still haunt its forests.

The unsurpassed natural advantages of the county are well in keeping with the resorts established there. Shasta Springs hotel combines high altitude, pure air, delightful climate and every form of sport in an ideal summering place. New and superbly appointed cottages, furnished with every convenience, attract many each year. Guests when tiring of mountain climbing can find at the resort every metropolitan amusement. A cement lined plunge is one of the attractions.

The celebrated Shasta springs water here bubbles from the earth, and was the attracting force which caused the establishment of the resort. Beautiful riding and driving avenues and a 50 mile private automobile boulevard rank high in their class.

The headwaters of the Sacramento river furnish magnificent trout fishing. Despite the many unsurpassed features, an outing at Shasta is not prohibitive in cost. The resort, which is operated on the American plan, is noted throughout the country for the excellence of its cuisine.

Castle Crags farm is a delightfully unique resort. Picturesque log cabins, fitted with every convenience of the most modern hotel, may be obtained at reasonable rates. The cabins are fitted with hot and cold showers, electric lights, modern plumbing, stone fireplaces and other features contributing to the homelike nature of the place. A private automobile road extends from the resort to Shasta springs and the McCloud river.

The resort is in the center of a great wooded tract containing 6,000 acres of primeval timber. Tennis, croquet, bowling, horseback riding, automobilizing, fishing, tramping and dancing are some of the amusements offered in this luxurious camping spot. The meals are served in a large dining hall. All vegetables and poultry are from the resort's private ranch. Real home cooking completes the idyllic pleasures of the spot.

Shasta Springs is a famous resort of the district, affording modern metropolitan conveniences with the delights of mountain climbing and big game hunting. Shasta Retreat is another delightful resort of Siskiyou county. Amid quiet surroundings one finds every advantage of outdoor life, combined with an excellent cuisine. Mineral springs of great medicinal value are close at hand. Shasta Retreat has many cottages for rent during the summer at reasonable rates.

western Pacific railroad, Russian River Terrace offers more of transportation facilities than does any of the other resorts along the river. Another distinctive feature of the park colony is the permanency of the improvements that have been put in: the road system, the water system and the conveniences of electric light and telephones.

Nestling in the embrace of a dozen different kinds of trees, from the majestic redwood to the trailing oak, the cottages in the Terraces, platforms and bungalows, have an appeal that few summer homes in the state can offer. Built high on the cliff, beside the river, the platform and bungalows standing vertically on the tree tops, there is a superb view of hill, valley, river and mountain that is unequalled.

The locations for bungalows in this park are selling fast. There is an exclusiveness about the general plan of development that makes the Terraces especially attractive to those who like to "know who their neighbors are."
