First Person to Arrange Parliamentary Practice According to Fundamental Principles

An aptitude amounting almost to genius has resulted in the appointment of Miss Alice Leone Fleenor, an undergraduate student of the University of California, hardly out of her teens, as parliamentary instructor of other students in the university; the men who are enrolling in the university extension work.

Miss Fleenor is the first person to arrange parliamentary practice in a scientific manner. She has evolved from its multitudinous rules five abstract and fundamental principles. These principles are taught in lectures. Then when the essentials are learned the students are given actual parliamentary training and are taught to conduct their assemblies according to the principles of parliamentary usage and their thoughts according to the laws of logic.
