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PROPOSALS FOR TWINE

SEALED PROPOSALS will be received at this Department until 10 o'clock A. M. on November 15, 1862, for furnishing one year's supply of Twine, estimated at 20,000 pounds, to be delivered at the Bank Agency, New York City.

The Twine must be of three strands, well twisted, and capable of sustaining the weight of 25 pounds on a string five feet in length. It must be put up in bales of one pound weight each and packed suitably for transportation in packages of not less than 100 pounds.

The Twine must be of such quality that it will stand samples of such twine as they propose to furnish with their bids.

The contract will be awarded to the lowest and best bidder, the best bid to be determined, after a careful examination, for the purpose of ascertaining which bid will, in its results, be most advantageous to the Department.

No proposals will be considered which may be made in violation of the regulations of the Department.

Each bidder must furnish with his proposals evidence of the ability to furnish the twine.

Two sufficient securities will be required to a contract.

Failure to furnish the article contracted for promptly, or furnishing an article inferior to that specified, will be considered a sufficient cause for the forfeiture of the contract.

Bids not made in accordance with these proposals will not be considered by the Department.

Proposals must be marked on the outside of the envelope with the name of the article proposed, for Twine, and sealed with the name of the bidder.
